ORDINANCE NUMBER 16 – 55

ORDINANCE RELOCATING THE STOP SIGN ALONG EAST SECOND STREET FROM SOUTH COLLIER STREET TO SOUTH WHITEMAN STREET AND CONSTRUCTING A NEW PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK AT SOUTH WHITEMAN STREET

WHEREAS, City of Xenia Staff deems it necessary to provide a safe means for its employees to access the new City Administration Building; and

WHEREAS, to achieve a safe means of access to the City Administration Building, it is necessary to erect a new STOP sign and crosswalk on E. Second Street at S. Whiteman Street; and

WHEREAS, an independent traffic study has deemed the existing STOP sign on E. Second Street at S. Collier Street to be unnecessary; and

WHEREAS, because the STOP sign is no longer needed at the intersection of E. Second Street and S. Collier Street, it is logical to relocate it to the intersection of E. Second Street and S. Whiteman Street where it was deemed necessary; and

WHEREAS, to coincide with the erection of a new STOP sign at the intersection of E. Second Street and S. Whiteman Street, it is necessary to construct an accessory pedestrian crosswalk to facilitate access to both sides of E. Second Street; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2016, the Xenia Traffic Commission unanimously endorsed a plan to relocate the STOP sign and construct an accessory pedestrian crosswalk.


NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Xenia hereby ordains:

Section 1. The STOP sign on E. Second Street at S. Collier Street will be relocated to S. Whiteman Street.

Section 2. A pedestrian crosswalk will be constructed across E. Second Street at S. Whiteman Street to facilitate access to both sides of the street.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

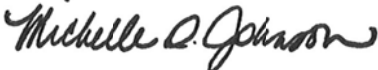

Current Stop Sign Arrangement

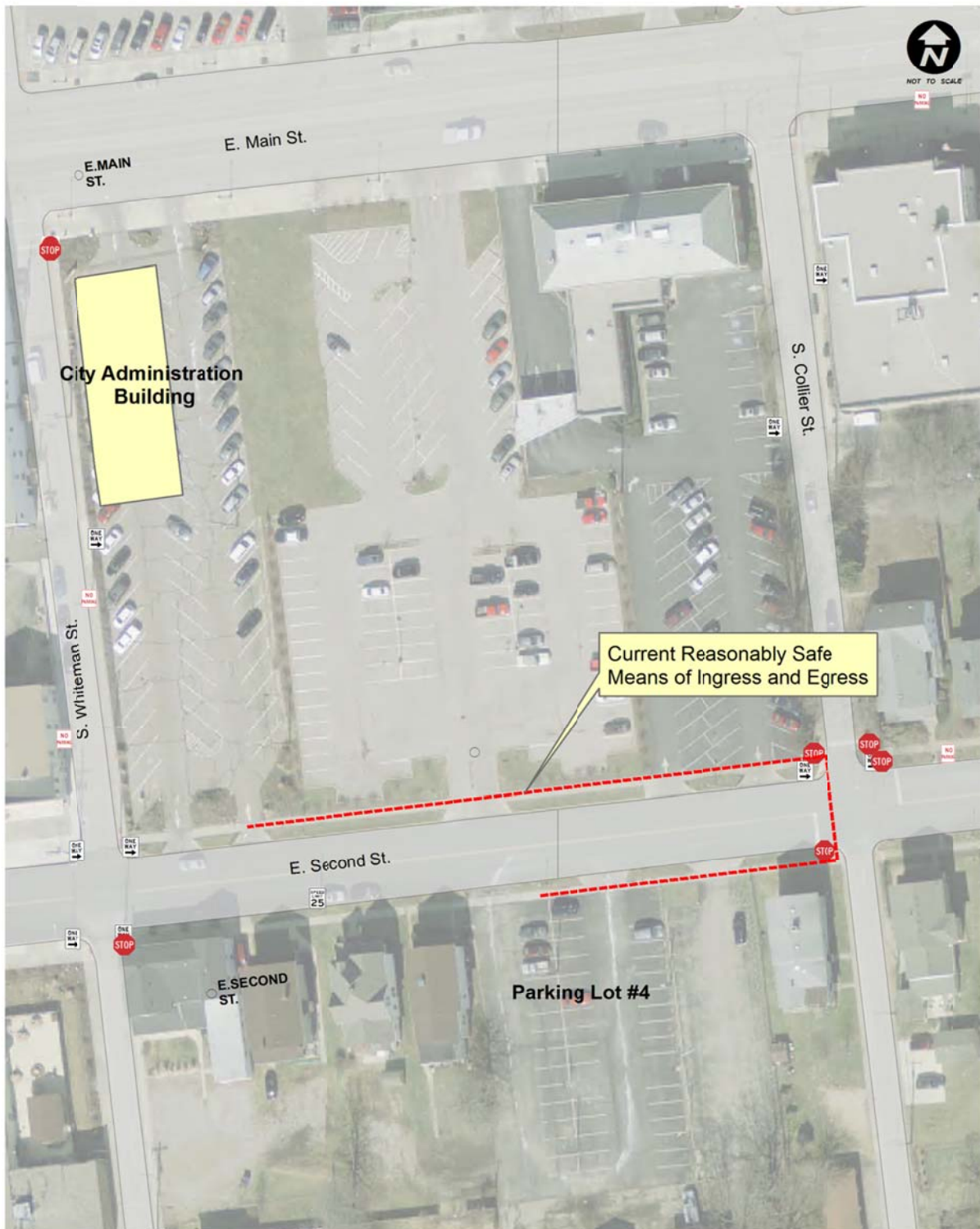


Exhibit B:
