Officer Barlow graduated from Xenia High School in 1984. He completed the police academy at the Greene County Police Academy in 1987.

Officer Barlow began his career in 1987 as a Reserve Officer and served in this capacity until he was hired as full-time Officer on March 2, 1992. Officer Barlow accepted many specialized assignments during his career with the police division. He worked as a Detective Hostage Negotiations Team Member, Property Room Manager, on the Internet Child Protection Unit, as a Computer Voice Stress Analyzer and acting Patrol Sergeant.

Officer Barlow received many commendations recognizing his professional conduct and performance throughout his career. He received the "Casey Elliott Xenia's Finest Award" in 2000 in recognition for all of his work and accomplishments with the Internet Child Protection Unit.
