City of Xenia sets New Date for rained-out Franklin Park Neighborhood Night Out

Xenia, Ohio (April 29, 2016) – The City of Xenia has rescheduled an earlier rained-out “Neighborhood Night Out” series in Xenia for Wednesday, May 4, 2016, from 5 to 7 pm in Franklin Park, 594 Dayton Avenue, Xenia, Ohio 45385. “Neighborhood Night Out” is a program offered by Xenia as city employees go to neighborhoods over the summer and spring to meet and greet citizens, solicit input and share city news and updates with citizens over hot dogs and snacks.

“We’re interested in hearing from residents and taxpayers and will begin our second season of Neighborhood Night Out programs this year in Xenia’s Franklin Park neighborhood. We hope to share updates about things going on in the City overall and to hear directly from residents of the area over any concerns they may have in their immediate neighborhood,” said Xenia City Manager Brent Merriman. A torrential rain and wind storm forced us to cancel the earlier Franklin Park Neighborhood Night Out, but It looks like the weather will be on our side for the event scheduled Wednesday, May 4th,” he added.

The city will team with Xenia Community Schools, Central State University and Greene Memorial Hospital to share information at the event. In addition to food and conversation, the City will have bouncy houses for kids, music and other materials of interest to citizens.
