Xenia unveils new virtual one-stop shop for permitting



The City of Xenia is pleased to now offer a new, more user-friendly online permitting experience, a single starting point for all City and County permits.

It's an easy to find portal on the City's site, www.explorexenia.com, [just click on 'Permits.'](#) The online app will estimate City fees, which can also be paid online, and allows users to upload their plans and electronically submit zoning and permitting applications. The app also figures out which County permit a user needs, and provides links to the appropriate County applications.

The permitting webpage also contains links to one-page reference guides for various types of permits, fee information, zoning map/code, public improvement design standards, and County regulatory agencies - helping you plan your project before you apply for a permit.
